
Dunwoody - invite your family and friends, people who love football and might be interested in Rotary and all we do to Bring Hope to the World.

Tony Barnhart is in his 47th season of covering college football for radio, television and the internet. He was a college football analyst for eight years with the SEC Network, and before that, a college football analyst for CBS Sports and a reporter for ESPN's College Game Day.

Tony spent 25 years at The Atlanta-Journal Constitution as a college football writer and has authored five books on college football. Two of the books are the autobiographies of Vince Dooley and Larry Munson. Tony's sixth book "The 19 of Greene" will be released in October.

Tony is a 1976 graduate of Grady College, the school of Journalism at the University of Georgia. He has been inducted into the school's Grady Fellowship, signifying career achievement and contributions to Journalism.

Service Opportunity: FODAC

Do You Have Home Medical Equipment to Donate?



For the last several years, Dunwoody has participated in the DeKalb Rotary Council's annual FODAC (Friends of Disabled Adults and Children) equipment drive. Dave Burr is leading the effort for Dunwoody. There are two ways you can help:

- Donate Home Medical Equipment: FODAC is looking for Manual & Electric Wheelchairs (including footrests), Scooters, Standers, Adaptive Strollers, Corner chairs, Gait trainers, Rollators, Shower supports, Toilet supports, Therapy aides, Specialized mattresses (no regular mattresses), Walkers, Canes, Crutches, & Forearm Crutches, Bathing aids, Braces, Air casts, Hoyer lifts, Hospital beds ... items can be taken to the 57th Fighter Group Restaurant on the day of collection or pick-up can be scheduled with a call a few days before the event.
- Volunteer to Help with Pick-Up: We need trucks, trailers and volunteers to help collect donations on Saturday, August 5! The group will meet at 8:30 AM on the back patio of the 57th Restaurant (next to PDK Airport on Clairmont Road in Chamblee for breakfast and socializing before heading out to pick up equipment at 9 or 9:30. We are usually done between 1 and 2.

Over the years, this project has collected approximately \$1,800,000 worth of durable medical equipment from local residents and businesses in the metro Atlanta area that is refurbished and redistributed to those in need in our community by FODAC.
