Year-End Rotary Fundraising Report

District 6900 has released a four-year analysis of our club's fundraising. The analysis includes Annual Fund, PolioPlus, approved Foundation Grants, Other Giving, and Endowment contributions for each year.

We surpassed our 2025-2026 Annual Fund goal of \$26,000 by \$3,150, with per capita giving of \$235. The district per capita giving rate was \$178. Our four-year Annual Fund giving average was \$35,262.



Our Polio Plus contributions totaled \$5,016, bringing our total giving for the year to \$34,166, a decline from the previous year's total of \$57,322.

GRSP giving is reported separately.
